Grown from a Rotary Club millennium project and now an independent, internationally recognised disaster relief charity, ShelterBox provides emergency shelter and other essential items to people across the world who have lost their homes to disaster or conflict.

Alex joined ShelterBox in 2014 after serving for 16 years with the British Army. Her roles in the Army included operations, training, human resources and sub-unit command. On operational deployment to Kosovo, Alex served as the liaison officer between the local community, NGOs, UN agencies and the military. During this time, she saw the impact, both positive and negative, that aid agencies can have on local populations affected by disaster.

Alex has represented ShelterBox for nearly 9 years including supporting responses in Sri Lanka (flooding and landslides in 2016) and Paraguay (widespread flooding in 2019) and at international conferences around the world.
